RE: COVID-19 Extension of 30-Day Supply of Enteral Nutrition to Medicare Beneficiaries

Dear Healthcare Suppliers and Providers,

The Healthcare Nutrition Council (HNC)¹ is writing to share our perspectives and request for collaboration regarding the recent [Medicare decision](#) to allow beneficiaries to obtain enteral nutrition (EN) products beyond the 30-day supply in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

HNC is committed to ensuring all patients have access to medically necessary products and we especially recognize how important these products are during this global pandemic. There is currently no shortage of EN products to meet patient needs. Manufacturers are working hard to ensure production is able to continue to meet demand during these difficult times. At this time, we are not aware of any disruptions in patient care or patients' inability to access EN product. We would like to continue to maintain this access. We are asking suppliers and providers to carefully consider individual patient needs, prior to dispensing EN product beyond 30 days unless the written order by the prescriber indicates the patient needs an extended supply due to being at high-risk or in quarantine due to COVID-19.

Please keep communication lines open with your respective manufacturer if there is a request for EN product beyond the 30-day supply to help ensure production can meet demand and prevent interruptions in the supply chain.
